Enclosed herewith is a copy of a Telegram to The Right Honourable Malcolm Fraser, Prime Minister of the Commonwealth of Australia dated 2nd June. 1978, advising him of the acceptance and application by us of the Geneva Conventions, First, Second, Third and Fourth dated 12th day of August One Thousand nine Hundred and forty nine.


On the 2nd December 1977 an Official State of War between the Commonwealth of Australia and this Principality was duly given by telegram to the Governor-General of Australia.

On the Fourth of December 1977 official notice by telegram of the cessation of the said State of War was given to the Governor-General of Australia.

We herewith officially notify you of our acceptance and application of the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedule of the Geneva Convention of Twelfth day August 1949.

This Territory was seceded from the Commonwealth of Australia on 21st April 1970, and has its own Government and Courts.
